

## **Easter – The Moving Holy Day**

You may wonder why Easter is not a fixed holy day like Christmas. Well, it's because the Church refers to the Jewish calendar in the case of the death and Resurrection of Christ.

The Church arranges her feast days according to the Gregorian calendar (movement of earth around the sun). Thus, Christmas is always on December 25<sup>th</sup>, the Assumption is always on August 15<sup>th</sup>, etc.

However, the Church retains the Jewish calendar (movement of the moon around the earth) for the celebration of Easter. This means Easter Sunday is always the Sunday after the first full moon that occurs after March 21<sup>st</sup>. This method of determining Easter is an *attempt* to tie the Feast to Passover as originally occurred with our Lord, who rose the day after the Sabbath of Passover. In this way, the Church emphasizes the identity between the **figurative** paschal lamb (liberation of Jews from Egypt) and the true Lamb of God (our liberation from sin through the death and resurrection of Christ).
