

IMMACULATE HEART OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY -SATURDAY, JUNE 17

FATHER'S DAY - JUNE 18th

Father's Day is a holiday of honoring fatherhood and paternal bonds, as well as the influence of fathers in society.

The nation's first Father's Day was celebrated on June 19, 1910, in the state of Washington. However, it was not until 1972 -58 years after President Woodrow



Wilson made Mother's Day official - that the day honoring fathers became a nationwide holiday in the U.S.

Father's Day has its beginning in 1908, after a West Virginia church sponsored the nation's first event explicitly in honor of fathers in memory of the 362 men who had died in the previous December's explosions at the Fairmont Coal Company mines. The next year, a Spokane, Washington woman named Sonora Smart Dodd, one of 6 children raised by a widower, tried to establish an official equivalent to Mother's Day for male parents. Washington State celebrated the nation's first statewide Father's Day on June 19, 1910. Slowly, the holiday spread. Today, the day honoring fathers is celebrated in the U.S. on the third Sunday of June.

Let us pray that all fathers and men serving in a fatherly role, follow the loving, trusting example of St. Joseph, the earthly father of Jesus.
