



# MOST HOLY TRINITY - SUNDAY, JUNE 4, 2023

Most Holy Trinity Sunday is celebrated a week after Pentecost Sunday and honors the most fundamental of Christian beliefs—belief in the Holy Trinity. Though the human mind can never fully understand the mystery of the Trinity, it can be summed up as follows: God, is three Persons in one Nature. There is only one God and three persons of God (Father, Son, Holy Spirit) are all equally God and They cannot be divided.

The origins of the celebration of Trinity Sunday go back to the Arian heresy of the 4th century. Arius, a Catholic priest, believed that Jesus Christ was a created being rather than God. Airus' chief opponent, Athanasius, upheld the orthodox doctrice that there are three Persons in one God, and the orthodox view prevailed at the Council of Nicaea, from which we get the Nicene Creed. It was established as a feast day in 1334 by Pope John XXII.

# Faith Formation Corner

On Sunday, May 28th we celebrated the solemnity of *Pentecost*, the *day* on which the gift of the Holy Spirit came down on the disciples. This makes it the perfect day to celebrate the Sacrament of Confirmation for adults who have been preparing and have a new awareness of the Spirit in their lives. We congratulate the four adults that received the sacrament of Confirmation on Pentecost which also completed our sacraments for the year.

This past Thursday, we held our Grade 7 Zoom meeting for our Academy and Faith Formation students preparing to move into Confirmation Year 2 preparation. Grade 8 requirements were reviewed. We are excited to continue the process of confirmation preparation for our Grade 7 students.
