



WHY DO CATHOLICS GENUFLECT?

This is a good time for us at Sacred Heart to reflect on this question. The Tabernacle has been returned to the center and the Presence of Jesus is more obvious to us. Very often we do it out of habit and don't know why. Some of us "older folks" might even remember going to a movie theatre or auditorium and genuflecting before going into the row! What does the word genuflect mean? Well, it comes from two Latin words that mean to "bend the knee". There are three things that we are saying by doing that:

- We genuflect out of humility. We lower ourselves to the One who is higher than us by nature. Jesus is greater than us and we are always subservient to Him.
- We commit ourselves to Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament. We prostrate ourselves before Christ the King as a soldier would bow and lay down his sword to his king.
- It is an act of love. Just as a man would get on one knee before the woman he wants to marry, we tell Jesus that we give Him all our love and dedicate the love we have for others to Him.

So the next time we come into Church, let's pause for a moment and let this outward sign remind us of the gift we have in the Real Presence of Jesus.

Happy Summer! We hope everyone is enjoying summer break thus far. The Sacred Heart Catholic Academy Summer Camp is in full swing and going great.



FORMED, produced by the Augustine Institute, has come to Sacred Heart and is available without charge to all parishioners. All that is needed to visit the website is internet Access and an e-mail account.
