



THE REAL PRESENCE OF CHRIST

A study conducted by the Pew Research Center indicated that only 31% of Catholics believe in the Real Presence of Christ in the Eucharist. This lead to the National Eucharistic Revival—a three year initiative launched on the Feast of Corpus Christi in 2022 with a mission to 'renew the Church by enkindling a living relationship with the Lord Jesus Christ in the Holy Eucharist."

We participate in this revival every time we receive the Eucharist (free from mortal sin,) having fasted one hour before receiving His Body and Blood. We participate in this revival when we display reverence by bowing before receiving the Eucharist, believing inwardly that we are about to receive the living Christ. We participate in this revival by devotedly genuflecting (if we are able) when we enter and exit the Church, by "Crossing" ourselves with the Sign of the Cross in public when we pass a Catholic Church to acknowledge the Real Presence of Christ and by reverently cradling the Holy Eucharist in our hands—the Body and Blood of our Lord, Jesus Christ.
