





PENTECOST SUNDAY MAY 19, 2024

The word Pentecost is Greek and it means "50th day." Fifty days after Easter Sunday, we celebrate the coming of the Holy Spirit upon the Apostles, their followers and the beginning of their Earthly ministry to make

disciples of all nations.

At Pentecost, the Apostles and their followers were gathered in a room. Jews from all over the world were gathered with Peter. A great wind blew and a flame appeared as a tongue of fire, which split itself into many individual flames above the heads of all those present. The Holy Spirit came upon those gathered and they began to speak in tongues. Despite the fact that many had no common language, they were perfectly able to understand one another. Three thousand people were baptized that day. This was the beginning of the Catholic Church. The symbols of Pentecost are the flame, wind and the dove which represent the Holy Spirit. The color of Pentecost is red and the priest wears red vestments on this day.
