SOLEMNITY OF THE ASSUMPTION OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY AUGUST 15TH

The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin is a singular participation in her Son's Resurrection and an anticipation of the resurrection of other Christians."

Easy and fun ways to participate in celebrating the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary with your family: 1) Go to Mass; 2) Place a statue of Mary on your family table and place fresh flowers before it; 3) Read books on Mary with your children; 4) Celebrate with a Marian themed tea party!
