



We hope everyone had a relaxing and fun summer vacation! The new school year begins this week for both our Academy and Faith Formation families. To celebrate the new school year, we invite all of our Academy and Faith Formation families to our Sunday, September 15th mass at 9:30 am. At this special mass we will celebrate both Catechetical Sunday and Blessing of the Backpacks! Please join Fr. On Tuesday, September 3rd the Church celebrates the feast day of Saint Gregory the Great, Pope and Doctor of the Church. Pope Gregory is only one of two popes known as "The Great". Gregory's family was wealthy, pious and believed in public service. He tired of the worldly life and sold his estates and used the month to establish seven monasteries. Gregory was ordained a Deacon of Rome and wanted to lead an evangelizing mission to England with several monks. According to Saint Bede, Gregory was so popular a preacher that the Roman people refused to let him leave! He reluctantly became Pope and asked his friend, Saint Augustine, to go to the British Isles to spread the Good News. Gregory advised Augustine to proceed gently and approach pagan practices with alternative Christian feasts. Pope Gregory's slow tactics to avoid head-on confrontations led to the successful conversion of a continent and is widely considered as being responsible for creating Western Christianity as we know it.
