Finally, September 23rd marks the feast day of Saint Pius of Pietrelcina. Saint Pio as he is popularly known was often misunderstood. In fact, for many years, he was not allowed to celebrate Mass or speak with anyone beyond his monastery's walls. He did not give up even when facing all of these difficulties but rather prayed even harder. This lead him to a deep relationship with God and the quote below reminds us not to give up but rather to trust that God's timing is always perfect! Today Padre Pio is considered as having had one of the most remarkable cases of the stigmata (resembling the wounds of Christ) and is a Saint!

"Pray, wait, and do not worry. Worrying is useless. God is merciful and will listen to your prayer... Prayer is the best weapon we have; it is the key to the heart of God. You should speak to Jesus, not with your lips but with your heart." --St. Pio of Pietrelcina
