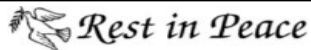

This Sunday, September 29th, we celebrate the Feast of the Archangels: Michael, Gabriel and Raphael - also known as Michaelmas. Angels are spiritual beings who act as intermediaries between God and humans. Did you know that Saint Michael is considered the Guardian of the entire Catholic Church.

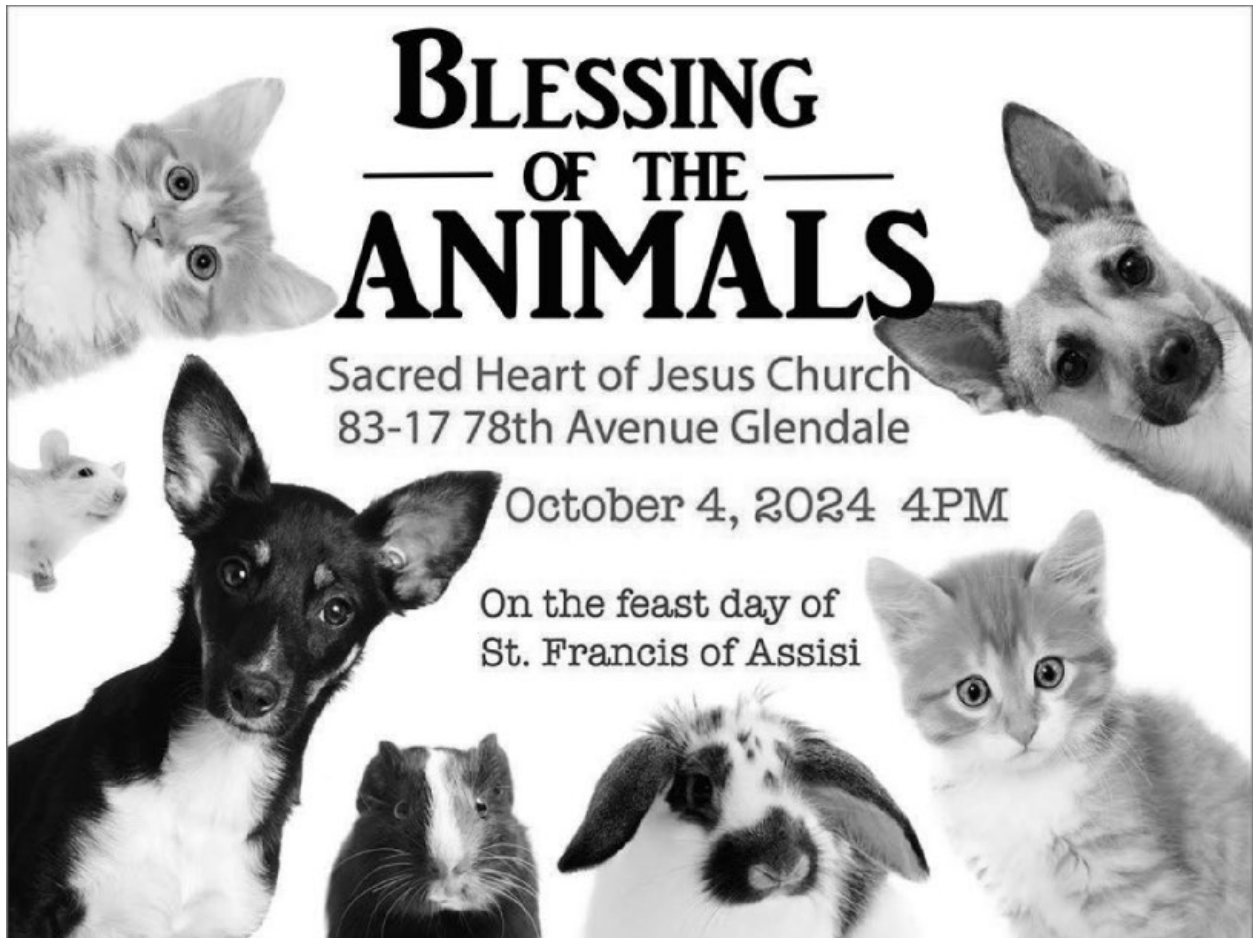

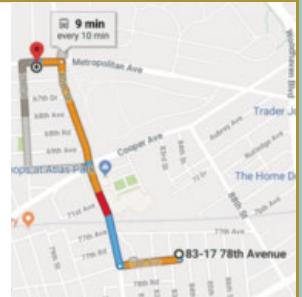
