

Brother Superior noticed that every day, when he arrived at the chapel to celebrate morning prayers with all the monks, there was a smell of freshly cut roses and he became curious, he couldn't find anyone that said they brought the roses to decorate the altar, and the rose bushes in the garden were not missing their flowers. The lay brother became seriously ill; the other monks noticed that the altar of the Virgin did not have the usual roses, and they deduced that it was the Brother who brought the roses. But how? Nobody had ever seen him leave the convent, nor did they know where he could buy the beautiful roses.

One morning they were surprised that he had risen, but they could not find him. At last, they met him in the chapel, and each monk who entered was amazed, for the lay brother was kneeling in front of the image of the Virgin, ecstatically reciting his Hail Marys, and at each one that addressed the Lady, a beautiful rose would appear in one of the vases!
