



Hospitality Sunday will be held today, October 13th after all the Masses. It is sponsored by Patty & Mike Gorton in memory of their parents.




HURRICANE RELIEF

On Saturday, October 12th, the Church celebrates Our Lady of Aparecida. The original statue of our Lady of Aparecida is reported to have been found by 3 Brazilian fishermen - Domingos Garcia, Filipe Pedroso and Joao Alves - who had been fishing for hours with no luck. Joao Alves decided to give it one last try before giving up

and threw his net back into the water. Drawing the net in they noticed it appeared that they had caught a statue without a head. Throwing his net out again, he pulled in the head of the statue. In response to instinct, he threw his net out a third time but this time he caught more fish then he could handle and his fellow fishermen cast their nets and also caught an abundance of fish. News spread quickly of this miracle, and more and more of their countrymen came to honor the Blessed Virgin Mary and to pray the Rosary! We celebrate our Lady of Aparecida on October 12th as this is the date of the finding of the original statue. Our Lady of Aparecida, pray for us!

This weekend also celebrates the Miracle of the Sun on Sunday, October 13th. Our Lady of Fatima is reported to have appeared to the 3 shepherd children on this date and newspapers published testimony from witnesses who said that they had seen extraordinary solar activity where the sun appeared to dance and zig-zag in the sky while advancing towards the earth. Meanwhile the 3 children reported seeing Jesus, Our Lady of Mount Carmel and Saint Joseph blessing the people. Our Lady of Fatima, pray for us!

All families registered into our Faith Formation program should now have logged into their *My Catholic Faith Delivered* classes. Please use the lesson threads to post any questions to your catechist or class.

This past week we hosted our mandatory child safety program in the Church for our Faith Formation program. It was wonderful to see how many children are well versed in basic child safety protocols and are eager to share important messages about safety! 

Finally, our Faith Formation families enrolled in our Grade/Level 1 Faith Formation MCFD course are expected to attend Mass on Sunday, October 20th at 9:30 AM. This will be followed by a meeting in the church basement. A parent is expected to accompany the child to the Mass and meeting.

Did you know? Pope St John Paul II became the first Pope to visit the Sanctuary of Aparecida, during his Apostolic Visit to Brazil in 1980. During his visit, he said, "What were the ancient pilgrims seeking? What are the pilgrims of today seeking? Precisely what they were seeking on the day, more or less distant, of Baptism: faith and the means of nourishing it. They seek the Sacraments of the Church, particularly Reconciliation with God and Eucharistic nourishment. And they set off again strengthened, and grateful to Our Lady the Mother of God and ours."
