

Dear Parishioners.

As early voting in New York State begins on Saturday, October 26th, the Catholic bishops of New York State have issued a statement entitled, "A Wolf in Sheep's Clothing," suggesting a negative vote this election year to Proposal 1 called the "Equal Rights Amendment." As the statement says, "The measure would, effectively, permanently legalize abortion without restriction and up until the moment of birth in New York State."

In addition, regarding parents and their children, "Courts could decide that parents have no authority over their minor children on important matters and permit children to make destructive and permanent decisions on their own which they could live to regret, including but not limited to so called 'gender affirming' treatments and surgeries."

Our own Bishop Robert Brennan recently stated in a letter to all priests: "The name of this proposal sounds promising, as many of us are inclined to advance equal rights. However, the text of Proposal 1 is broadly written and would have dangerous consequences if enacted."

I invite you to go to WWW.NYSCATHOLIC. ORG and PROTECTKIDSNY.COM to learn more about this imposing and unsafe legislation that will impact the Right to Life and the sacredness of family life.

Jesus, have mercy on us. Mary and Joseph, pray for us. Amen.
