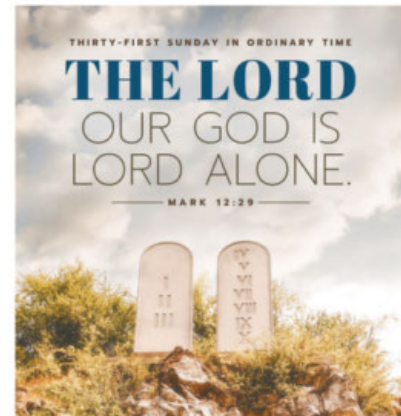

Sunday, November 3rd, the Church celebrates the feast day of Saint Martin de Porres. Born in Peru, Saint Martin's father left the family when Martin was young so he, his sister and mother had to make a living for themselves. Even with these difficulties, Martin often gave away his money or food to the poor. Martin became an apprentice to a barber/surgeon at age 12. He learned how to care for the ill and gained a reputation of taking care of anyone regardless of race or status. He even operated a veterinary hospital for dogs and cats, and earned the nickname, "the Saint Francis of the Americas" because of his love for animals. At age 15, Martin entered the Dominicans. Nine years later, he made his full religious profession. Always distributing alms, St. Martin de Porres raised generous amounts of money for the poor and grew fruit trees for them to use. He performed many miracles and levitated so often that he became known as the "flying brother".

Sunday, November 3rd at 9:30 am is our Grade/Level 2 Mass followed by a mini-retreat in the Church basement as part of our proximate preparation for the sacraments.

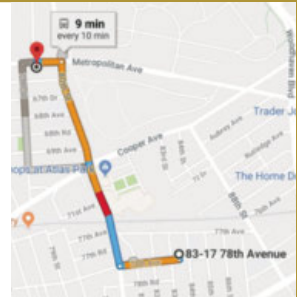
