



Saturday, November 9th, the Church celebrates the dedication of the Lateran Basilica. This Basilica is the oldest public church and the highest ranking of all the Papal basilicas in Rome. In the early days of Christianity, those who be-

lieved in Jesus met in private homes to celebrate the Eucharist due to persecution. Once they were no longer persecuted for the faith, they built beautiful churches to honor God. A palace owned by the noble Laterani family eventually became the property of Emperor Constantine who donated the site to build a church. It originally was given the title of the Basilica of the Savior, but later was dedicated to St. John the Baptist and then became known as St. John Lateran. St. John Lateran was the home of the popes for many years. While Pope Francis now lives at the Vatican, St. John Lateran is considered his cathedral as Bishop of Rome. In celebrating the dedication of the Lateran Basilica, we should be grateful for our own parish church and the cathedral of our diocese. A good way to express our gratitude is to spend some prayerful time in our own Sacred Heart of Jesus Church.

Tuesday, November 12th our Faith Formation Grades 1 -8 will join Fr. McBrien in the Church for a Faith Encounter meeting on the Mass. Families will walkthrough the beauty and meaning of the Mass with Fr. McBrien during this special session.

Looking ahead, November 17th at 9:30 am is our Grade/Level 8 class Mass followed by the second proximate prep presentation entitled "Full of Grace" in the Church basement. Attendance is mandatory for all candidates seeking the sacrament of confirmation.
