Did you know? Saturday, January 25th, we celebrate the conversion of Paul. Paul was originally known as Saul. Saul was a Jew of the tribe of Benjamin. To Saul, Christianity was a threat to Judaism. After he watched St. Stephen murdered for his faith, Saul became a leader in the movement to destroy Christianity. One day, as Saul was planning to harass the Christians of Damascus, a flash of light appeared and he fell to the ground and lost his sight. He heard a voice say, "Saul, Saul, why do you persecute me?" And he said, "Who are you, Lord?" And he said, "I am Jesus, whom you are persecuting." Following this, Saul was baptized and regained his sight. Saul, now known as Paul, then went to Jerusalem and preached there in the name of Jesus. The conversion of St. Paul is an opportunity to think about any times we have received a new insight into God or ourselves (i.e., after confession, during an emergency/crisis or while praying).

"So, if anyone is in Christ, there is new creation; everything old has passed away; see, everything has become new!" - (2 Corinthians 5:17)





It has a pope, bishops and priests, teachers, doctors, musicians, mothers and fathers, and even children. What do each of these people do for the Church?


