Hospitality Sunday is an opportunity to meet fellow parishioners, enjoy light refreshments, and have some fun.

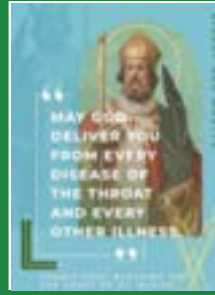

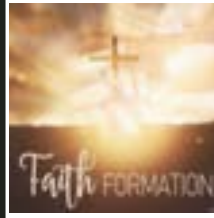

This Sunday, February 2nd, the Church celebrates the Presentation of the Lord and the Purification of Our Lady. This feast day celebrates the Presentation of Jesus in the Temple by Mary and Joseph. Mary, by law, had to wait 40 days to go to the temple after giving birth. While she did not need purification, she submitted to the law God established. This day is also known as Candlemas. Christ is the light who came into this world to dispel sin and darkness. For this reason, candles have been blessed at Mass this day that will be used throughout the year.

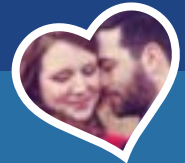
