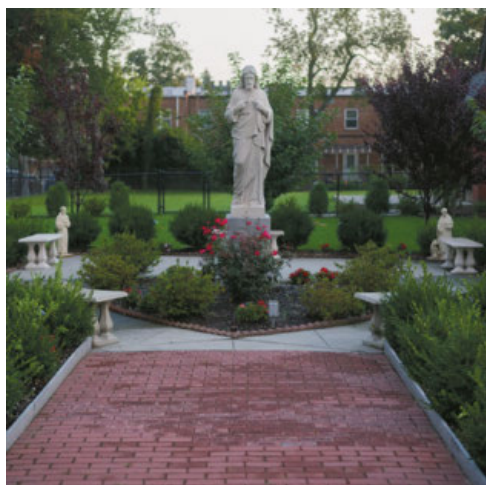

ANNUAL FINANCIAL REVIEW

Dear Parishioners,

The Parish Finance Council, parish trustees and I present the following “Statement of Revenues and Expenditures” from August 31, 2023 to August 31, 2024. We have much to be thankful for regarding our parish while unfortunately operating with a deficit of \$181,986 over the last year.

Following my arrival on July 1, 2024 and installation as pastor on September 29th, I have sought ways to decrease the deficit and prudently use the resources we have for the good of the parish. Reduced costs and utility usage, increased church membership, formation of a Parish Fund Raising Committee and transparency are some of the ways I believe we can move in the right direction.

Thank you for supporting the 2024 Annual Catholic Appeal and for your weekly contributions. You are wonderful. I encourage everyone to register in the parish and share in the sense of belonging with each other. If you do not receive the parish mailings please call the Rectory Office.

Sacred Heart Parish is a strong and vibrant parish that is dear to us. Our ideal is always to see it grow and become stronger with new families and expanding programs-spiritually, educationally, pastorally, socially and much more.

I kindly ask your help to reduce this deficit by prayerfully making a sacrificial increased offering of 20 percent. Could you increase your \$10.00 weekly offering to \$12.00, \$15.00 to \$18.00, \$20.00 to \$24.00, etc.? Such added gifts over the next year would exceed the amount of deficit listed below.

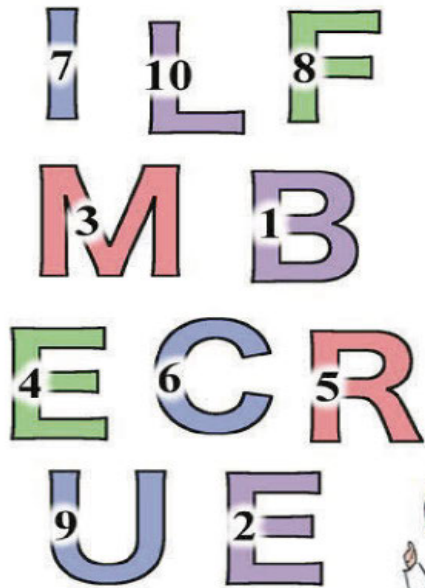

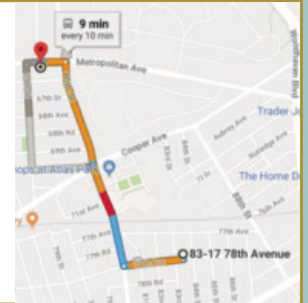
