



#### Here are some ideas for family Lent/Easter activities:

- 4. Go on a walk with your family and talk about how Jesus had to travel. Talk about the hardship that Jesus and his followers had to overcome as they walked for miles and miles, not always in nice conditions, to be sure that everyone knew about the Gospel. Talk about how you as a family walking together model the disciples accompanying Jesus on his travels.


